

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What happens during the session?

During the three-hour session the children will have the opportunity to make witches' brooms using twigs, they will create swirling magic potions and slimy, glow-in-the-dark ectoplasm. They w spooky scavenger hunt around the farm. The sessions are run by qualified staff with DBS clearance.

Do the sessions run all week?

The sessions run from Monday 23rd to Friday 27th October. Each session is a repeat, so just choose the time that suits you best. Spaces are limited however, so early booking is advised.

Who can take part? The sessions are pitched at children aged 8-13 years. Parent/Carers do not need to attend but they will need to leave emergency contact details.

When and Where?

Each session will last three hours and will take place at the Farm. We will meet outside the Eco Building. We will need to make a prompt start in order to maximise our time together. The Morning Session will run from 9am to 12pm.

The Afternoon Session will run from 12.30pm to 3.30pm

*There is the option to book a packed lunch from the café from 12.00-12.30. This costs £5.00 but is offered free to children who can show that they are eligible for Free School Meals. Is there a cost?


