
6RS have thoroughly enjoyed our PSHE topic this term - Celebrating Differences.





2 members of 3RM performed at the Liverpool Empire Theatre last Saturday with WAPA - the Wirral Academy of Performing Arts.


We have been told that they were both amazing and we are very proud of them!

Parking
