Our Approach to School Uniform

Uniform is something that identifies the children in the school as attending New Brighton Primary and is something for the children to wear with pride. It also allows all of the children to feel equal and removes the pressures and the cost of fashion from children and parents.

Parents, children and governors have been consulted in the intention of ensuring a consistent, cost effective and smart approach to school uniform as it has been identified and agreed that there are currently too many varieties of uniform to choose from.

We appreciate that uniform can cost a lot of money so have supported you by making the expectation of the school badge on the uniform optional.

A few points to consider - please ensure children have:

- Black shoes, or all black trainers
- Hair shaved no lower than number 2 with no tramlines, hair dye etc
- Gold or silver studs for earrings, not hoops or other jewellery. Simple watches are allowed.
- Plain dark socks under school trousers or with shorts.
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms without logos or stripes etc
- Charcoal grey trousers, skirts and shorts, not black

Regarding PE, we will continue with the children coming into school, in their PE kit on their allocated PE day and are asking children to wear plain black tracksuit bottoms/shorts and a plain coloured t-shirt based on the house team they are in.

Much of the uniform can be bought from supermarkets at a considerably reduced price.

Thank you in advance for your support and cooperation and we look forward to the children looking even smarter and feeling a greater sense of pride in New Brighton Primary School.

Daily uniform

Compulsory

White Polo top (Shirt / Blouse can continue to be worn if already purchased)

Black Shoes (or all black trainers)

Charcoal Grey Trousers / Shorts / Skirt

Seasonal (Optional)

Charcoal Grey Tights

Summer dress (Blue gingham)

Charcoal Grey Pinafore

Royal Blue Jumper / Cardigan (with or without the school logo)

Dark, non-patterned socks (For trousers / shorts)

White Knee High Socks (For Skirts)

PE Kit

Compulsory

Round Neck T- Shirt in house colour (Dalmorton: BLUE, Vaughan: RED, Seabank: YELLOW,

Maitland:GREEN,)

Black Shorts/Black Skirt/Black Cycling Shorts

White Socks

All black trainers (not pumps or crocs)

Seasonal (Optional)

Black Tracksuit Bottoms

Hooded Top (Optional)







Hair/Jewellery

Short hair no shorter than number 2

Long hair to be tied up

No hair dye

No jewellery other than plain studded gold/silver ear-rings and simple watches (not smart watches)

No excessive headwear

No false nails

Children can deviate from this on medical grounds and recognised SEND needs
