# Office Refurbishment

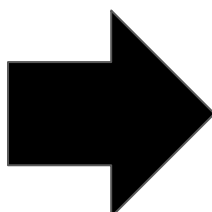
**Exciting news for our office staff - our long-awaited refresh of our front reception office is commencing on Monday!**
