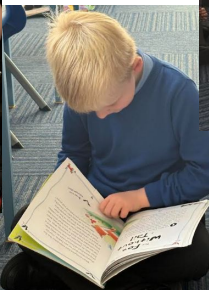

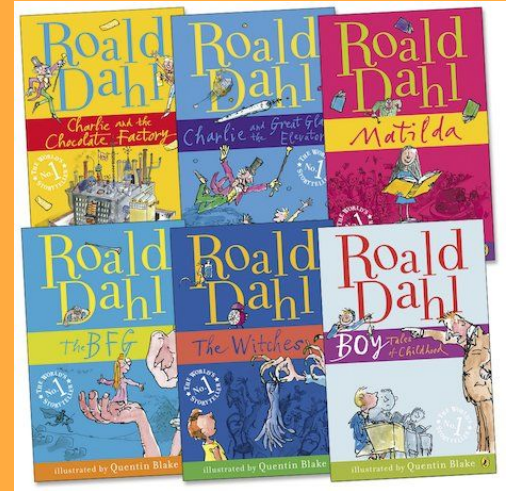
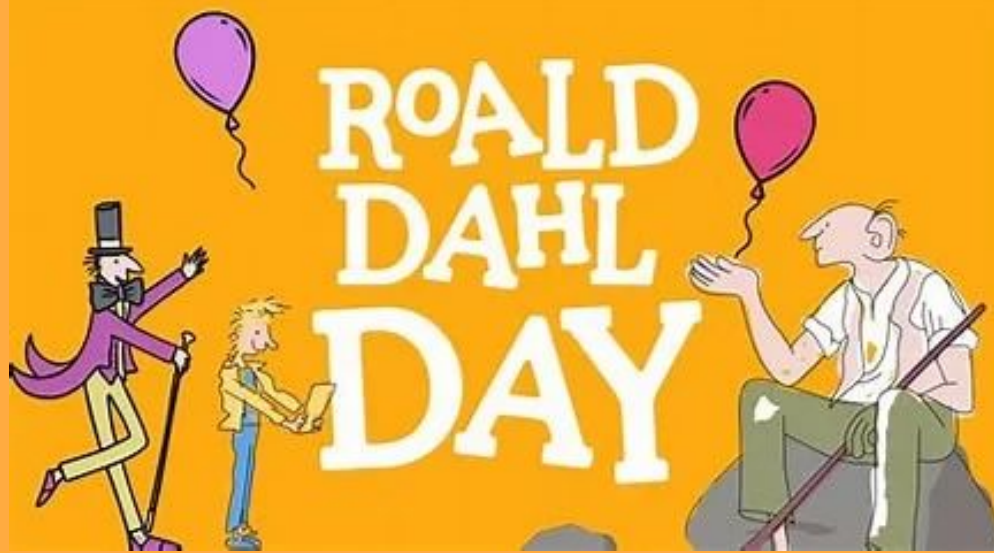


Little Princess Trust

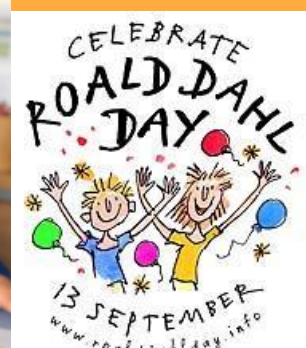
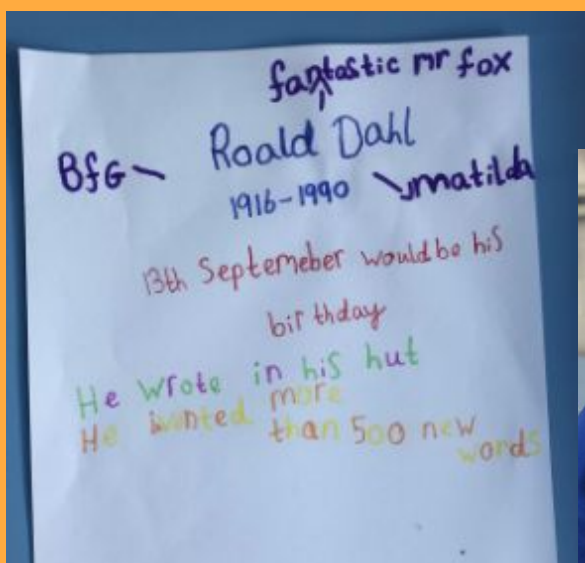
Giving Hair and Hope to children with cancer
