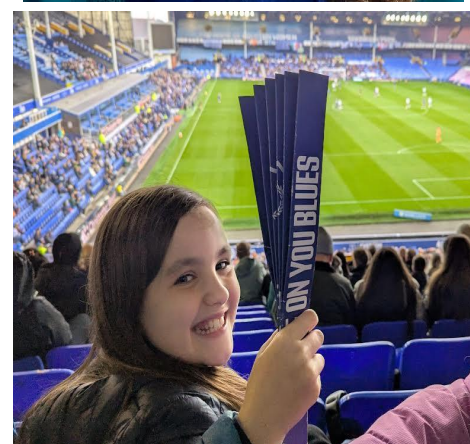




Everton in the Community
