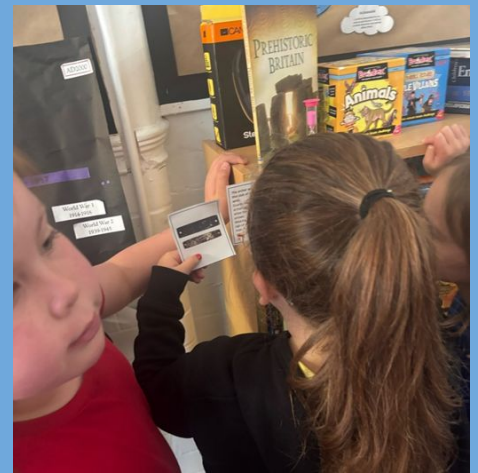




Science starts in 3CC

Just a gentle reminder about our school's expectations around drinks.

Children should only bring water in their water bottles during the school day.

If they wish, they may bring a small juice carton or drink to have with their packed lunch.

Fizzy drinks are not allowed in school.

We encourage water as it helps children stay hydrated and focused in class, without the negative effects of too much sugar. We also kindly ask that water is brought in reusable bottles, rather than disposable ones, to help reduce waste.
