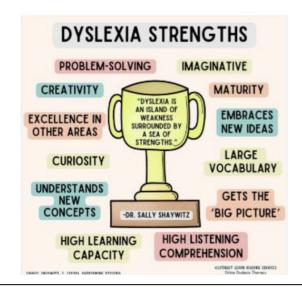


October is Dyslexia Awareness Month.

Just a gentle reminder about our school's expectations around drinks.
